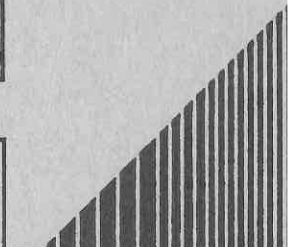

3. SUMMARY OF EVENTS

On 2008-05-12 the above mentioned members went on foot patrol in Site [REDACTED] Block, Khayelitsha. A suspect was searched and found in possession of 61 (Boss) mandrax tablets. The suspect was interviewed properly by the members. The suspect then pointed out the storage facility in [REDACTED] Khayelitsha. The address pointed out by the suspect was [REDACTED] in Khayelitsha.

The suspect [REDACTED], 22 years old of [REDACTED] Khayelitsha was detained at Khayelitsha, Site [REDACTED] and the members applied for a search warrant to search the storage facility. [REDACTED] was detained on Khayelitsha CAS [REDACTED] /2008-Possession of drugs. The suspect had outstanding cases pending against him as well. At 14:00 the premises were raided and found to be the big storage facilities for mandrax. Approximately 18 000 Boss

Mandrax tablets were found in one of the bedrooms that was closed. Total value at about R1000 000.00, the occupant that was found in the house was arrested in Khayelitsha CAS [REDACTED] 2008- Dealing in drugs, [REDACTED] 57 years old residing at same premises.

During further follow up investigation it was established that the sister [REDACTED] of [REDACTED] [REDACTED] was the person that had stored the mandrax. She was arrested by the Investigating Officer a few days after the raid. It needs to be mentioned that after the raid, it was established that [REDACTED] was also registered as one of the Organised Crime Highflyers. The case is therefore being investigated by the Project Manager, Insp [REDACTED] of Cape Town Organised Crime.

4. RECOMMENDATIONS

This is a very good success, it does put the emphasis on members not to only arrest but they should properly interview the suspect. Due to good policing a lot of mandrax was taken off the streets and out of the community. The Provincial Panel agreed when it sat on the 23-02-2010 that the four members should be awarded R10 000.00 each and a Commendation Certificate from the National Commissioner.

5. NOTE.

This application was recommended by the Western Cape Provincial Office and it was approved by the National Head Office but the name of [REDACTED] was omitted from the initial application and this office would like him to be awarded with cash in the amount R10 000.00 and a Commendation Certificate from the National Commissioner. The other three members were awarded R10 000.00 each and Commendation Certificates from the National Commissioner.

Summary of achievements:

Starting as a Sector Commander in sector 3 Khayelitsha during January 2012, Constable [REDACTED] was faced with a high rate of gang fighting in the area. During the past year, he arranged three Street Soccer tournaments in an attempt to get the youth to get to know their peers from surrounding areas and to minimize friction in the area. He also concentrates on scholars and has arrested numerous boys for carrying dangerous weapons. It is his belief to involve the parents of these youths as well and hope to improve a general sense of responsibility amongst all. Constable [REDACTED] also has a goal of combating crimes against women and children and often addresses the community on these issues through pamphlets, walk and talk campaigns, group discussions and forum meetings. His motto by which he is known is: "It's better to prevent misfortune than to remedy the consequences thereof".
